

Menuet

Partita in G minor, Clavierbüchlein vor Wilhelm Friedemann Bach no. 48, Mvmt. 4

Measures 1-10 of the Minuet. The piece is in 3/4 time and G minor. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth-note patterns and some grace notes. The left hand provides a harmonic accompaniment with chords and single notes.

Measures 11-21 of the Minuet. Measure 11 begins with a repeat sign. The piece continues with similar melodic and harmonic patterns, including a key signature change to G major (one flat) in measure 17.

Measures 22-31 of the Minuet. The piece concludes with a final cadence in G major. The right hand ends with a series of eighth notes, and the left hand provides a simple harmonic support.

This Menuet preserved as movement 4 of a Partita by Stölzel in the Clavier-Büchlein vor Wilhelm Friedemann Bach, where J.S. Bach added his Trio (Prelude) BWV 929.
