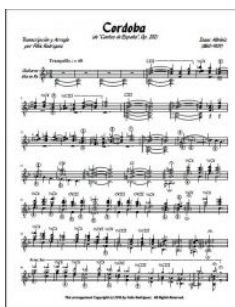
About the artist
