Comment:	As organist at Weimar, Johann Sebastian Bach was charged with providing a harmonic underpinning for the singing of Lutheran chorale tunes chosen for each day. Bach wrote out many of these harmonizations, in part as instruction for younger composers (many of which are still used for this purpose). A derivation of this practice, the organ chorale, as manifested in the chorale preludes, dates from 1713 -1714, about the time he became organist at Weimar. (more online)
