My primary instruments are: a nylon string Giannini, made in Brazil; a german Muller acoustic piano. My notation is all scribed using Finale Allegro notation software. My catalogue of free sheet music features a mixture of grades mainly from beginner to intermediate.

The opera is in four acts and the libretto was written by Henri Meilhac and Ludovic Halévy, who based their work on a novella of the same title by the author Prosper Mérimée. Carmen was first performed at the Opéra-Comique in Paris, on 3 March 1875. It was not very successful and its initial run only consisted of 36 performances.
