- Vlms. 1 & 2:** Play a melodic line in the first section (**mf**), then a rhythmic accompaniment in the second section (**p**), and a melodic line in the third section (**mf**). In the **Allegro** section, they play a melodic line starting with a **f** dynamic.
- Vlas.:** Play a rhythmic accompaniment in the first section (**mf**), then a rhythmic accompaniment in the second section (**p**), and a rhythmic accompaniment in the third section (**mf**). In the **Allegro** section, they play a rhythmic accompaniment starting with a **f** dynamic.
