The left hand has quarter notes G3-A3 in measures 9 and 10, and quarter notes B3-C4 in measures 11 and 12. A repeat sign is present at the beginning of measure 9.

The fourth system of the piece, measures 13-16. The right hand has quarter notes G4-A4, eighth notes B4-A4-G4, quarter notes F4-E4, and eighth notes D4-C4. The left hand has quarter notes G3-A3 in measures 13 and 14, and quarter notes B3-C4 in measures 15 and 16. A repeat sign is present at the beginning of measure 13.

The fifth system of the piece, measures 17-20. The right hand has quarter notes G4-A4, eighth notes B4-A4-G4, quarter notes F4-E4, and eighth notes D4-C4. The left hand has quarter notes G3-A3 in measures 17 and 18, and quarter notes B3-C4 in measures 19 and 20. A repeat sign is present at the beginning of measure 17.
