Comment: The grace notes and staccato found in this piece make for a colorful tune. The tempo marking is denoted as moderato, a relaxed pace in which the mood is raised. The horn is a brass instrument also known as the corno or French horn. It has 20 feet (6.1m) of tubing which is wrapped into a coil, and ends in a flared bell. A player of the horn is referred to as a horn player, or less commonly a hornist. The instrument has its origins in Germany,... (more online)
