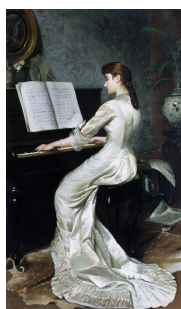

Measures 1-3 of the piece. The music is in 4/4 time and B-flat major. The right hand (RH) plays a series of eighth-note triplets, while the left hand (LH) plays a steady eighth-note accompaniment. Measure 3 ends with a fermata over the final note.

Measures 4-6. The right hand continues with eighth-note triplets, and the left hand provides a consistent accompaniment. Measure 6 features a fermata over the final note.

Measures 7-9. The right hand plays eighth-note triplets, and the left hand continues with its accompaniment. Measure 9 ends with a fermata over the final note.

Measures 10-13. The right hand plays eighth-note triplets, and the left hand continues with its accompaniment. Measure 13 includes a *dim.* (diminuendo) marking. Measure 13 ends with a fermata over the final note.

Measures 14-16. The right hand plays eighth-note triplets, and the left hand continues with its accompaniment. Measure 16 ends with a fermata over the final note.
