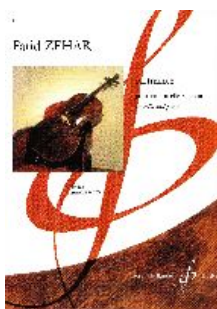

TEMPO DI VALZER
