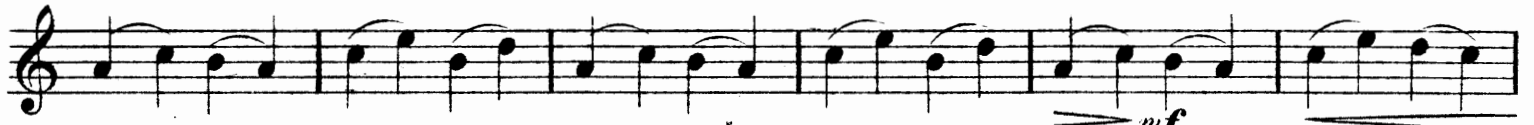

The first section of the Valse consists of 12 measures in 3/4 time. It begins with a piano (*p*) dynamic and a *Solo. cantabile* instruction. The melody is characterized by flowing eighth and sixteenth notes, often beamed together. There are several rests and slurs throughout the passage.
