### VIOLINO.

*Allegro molto.*

The first movement, *Allegro molto*, is written for the violin in G minor and 3/4 time. It begins with a piano (*p*) dynamic and a second ending. The music is characterized by rapid sixteenth-note passages and trills. Dynamics range from piano (*p*) to fortissimo (*fp*). The movement concludes with a first ending and a final cadence.

*Adagio poco Andante.*
