Waly) is a folk song of Scottish origin, based on lyrics that partly date to the 1600s. It remains popular in the 21st century. Cecil Sharp published the song in Folk Songs From Somerset (1906). O Waly, Waly has been a popular choice for arrangements by classical composers, in particular Benjamin Britten, whose arrangement for voice and piano was published


