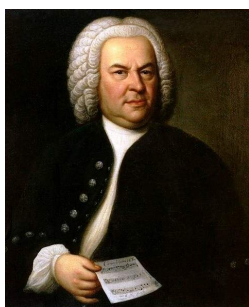

Invention No. 2

Johann Sebastian Bach (1685–1750)

Transc. Bernard Dewagtere
