Comment: Assigned to the Bach catalog in the nineteenth century but la

thought not to be Bach's work, this little chorale prelude gaine bit more legitimacy in 1985 when it turned up in the Neumeist Manuscript at Yale University in the company of other chorale (some previously unknown) fairly solidly attributed to Bach. The melody is not one that Bach seems to have set otherwise. Its statement sounds distracted, almost fragmentary, wandering.
