Measures 1-4 of the score. The piece is in 3/4 time. The right hand features a melodic line with frequent trills (tr) and slurs. The left hand provides a steady accompaniment. Dynamics include *ff* (fortissimo) and *f* (forte).

Measures 5-9 of the score. The right hand continues with trills and slurs. The left hand has some rests in measures 5 and 6. Dynamics include *f* (forte).

Measures 10-13 of the score. The right hand has trills and slurs. The left hand has rests in measures 10 and 11. Dynamics include *mf* (mezzo-forte), *ff* (fortissimo), and *mf* (mezzo-forte). Measure 13 ends with a double bar line and repeat signs.
