Measures 17-20: The guitar part continues with quarter notes G8, A8, B8, C9, D9, E9, F9, and a dotted half note G9. The bassoon part continues with quarter notes G6, A6, B6, C7, D7, E7, F7, and a dotted half note G7.

Measures 21-24: The guitar part continues with quarter notes G9, A9, B9, C10, D10, E10, F10, and a dotted half note G10. The bassoon part continues with quarter notes G7, A7, B7, C8, D8, E8, F8, and a dotted half note G8.
