Harpisichord

The first system of the harpsichord part consists of four measures. The key signature is three sharps (F#, C#, G#) and the time signature is 6/8. The music begins with a repeat sign. The right hand plays a melody of eighth notes, while the left hand provides a bass line of eighth notes.

The second system of the harpsichord part consists of four measures, starting at measure 4. It continues the melody and bass line from the first system.

The third system of the harpsichord part consists of four measures, starting at measure 8. It includes a first ending (1.) and a second ending (2.) for the right hand, which leads to a repeat sign.

The fourth system of the harpsichord part consists of four measures, starting at measure 12. It continues the melody and bass line.

The fifth system of the harpsichord part consists of four measures, starting at measure 16. It includes a first ending (1.) and a second ending (2.) for both hands, which concludes the piece with a double bar line.
