Harpe

The first system of the harp part, measures 1-7. The music is in the key of D major (two sharps) and 3/4 time. The right hand plays a series of eighth-note chords, while the left hand plays a steady eighth-note bass line.

Hpe

The second system of the harp part, measures 8-15. The right hand features a melodic line with some chords, and the left hand continues with a rhythmic bass line.

The third system of the harp part, measures 16-21. The right hand has a more active melodic line, and the left hand provides harmonic support.

The fourth system of the harp part, measures 22-27. The right hand plays a series of chords and eighth-note patterns, while the left hand maintains a consistent bass line.

The fifth system of the harp part, measures 28-35. The right hand has a complex texture with many chords, and the left hand plays a rhythmic bass line.
