I studied in depth, especially these three great musicians and I have practiced in the manuals of harmony of Farina, Buboïs and Schömberg. I specialized in composition and in imitative canon at different intervals, some for fun, a bit because I believe that music, like any art, should rest his mission to communicate the beauty, starting from solid technical foundations. I did all this simply because I liked it, as a painter captures an image, relies to her a message and places it on a canvas, as a sculptor reveals a life trapped in a stone, as well as a poet crystallizes and solidifies the most subtle feelings of the soul, so, finally, as a musician carries, on the endle...
