About the artist

Roberto Di Girolamo, composer - Prossedi, Italy, 1959 - started as a saxophonist studying at the Italian Conservatory with Baldo Maestri, during this period he was part of the Gerardo Iacouccis Big Band which performed in the most prestigious clubs in the Capital, with the same he participated in various television programmes. In 1980 a debilitating accident made him a quadriplegic. Not being able to play the saxophone or any other instrument, in 1985 he landed in Composition with Daniele Paris. After a few years for health reasons, he left his academic studies and then continued as a self-taught with the precious advice of Carlo Savina. In 1990 he gave his first concert, entirely with his compositions, with orchestra and solo instruments, and since then other concerts in various genres Jazz, Classic, Contemporary, Sacred music, etc, conceiving and implementing new projects in collaboration with his partner Maki Maria Matsuoka, opera singer. Detailed description: This system contains measures 15 and 16. The first violin (VLN. I) and second violin (VLN. II) parts are marked *mp* and feature intricate sixteenth-note patterns. The viola (VLA.) and cello (VC.) parts are marked *mf* and play a steady eighth-note accompaniment. The key signature has one flat (B-flat), and the time signature is 4/4.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 17 and 18. The violin parts continue with their melodic lines, while the viola and cello provide harmonic support with eighth-note patterns. The dynamics remain consistent with the previous system.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 19 and 20. The melodic lines in the violins and the accompaniment in the viola and cello continue. The overall texture is dense due to the fast sixteenth-note passages in the upper strings.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 21, 22, and 23. In measure 21, the violin parts play a complex sixteenth-note figure. In measure 22, the violin parts continue. In measure 23, the violin parts are silent, and the viola and cello parts are marked *f* and *mp* respectively, playing a more active accompaniment.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 24 to 28. Measures 24-27 are mostly rests for all instruments. In measure 28, all instruments enter with a triplet of eighth notes. The strings (VLA. and VC.) play a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes. Dynamics include *mp* and *CRES.* (crescendo). A fermata is placed over the final note of the triplet in measure 28.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 29 to 32. Measures 29-30 feature a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes with triplets. Dynamics range from *f* (forte) to *mf* (mezzo-forte). Measures 31-32 continue the pattern with triplets and accents. A fermata is placed over the final note of the triplet in measure 32.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 33 to 36. Measures 33-34 feature a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes with triplets. Measures 35-36 continue the pattern with triplets and accents. A fermata is placed over the final note of the triplet in measure 36.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 37 to 40. Measures 37-38 feature a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes with triplets. Dynamics range from *f* (forte) to *mp* (mezzo-piano). Measures 39-40 continue the pattern with triplets and accents. A fermata is placed over the final note of the triplet in measure 40.
