Bassoon

Measures 1-2: The guitar part features a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes with slurs and accents. The bassoon part provides a simple harmonic accompaniment with quarter notes and rests.

Measures 3-4: The guitar part continues with the eighth-note pattern, including a key signature change to one sharp (F#) in measure 4. The bassoon part continues with its accompaniment.

Measures 5-6: The guitar part continues with the eighth-note pattern. The bassoon part continues with its accompaniment.

Measures 7-8: The guitar part continues with the eighth-note pattern. The bassoon part continues with its accompaniment, ending with a double bar line.

Measures 9-10: The guitar part continues with the eighth-note pattern, marked with a *rit.* (ritardando) instruction. The bassoon part continues with its accompaniment, ending with a double bar line.
