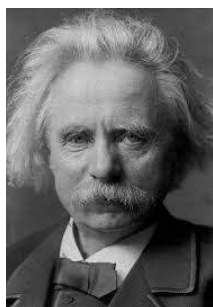
About the artist

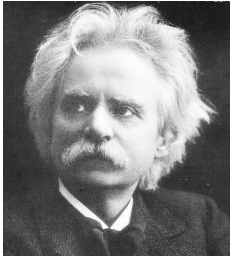




