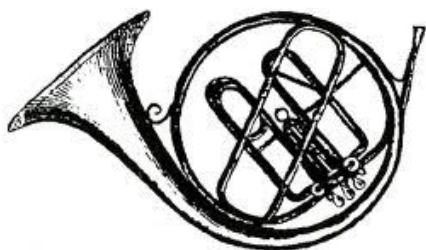
## About the artist

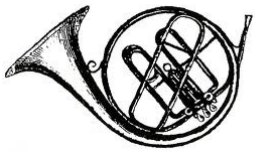
