Measures 23-25: The treble clef part features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the bass clef part provides a harmonic accompaniment with quarter and eighth notes.

Measures 26-28: The treble clef part continues the melodic development with eighth notes and rests, and the bass clef part maintains the accompaniment with quarter notes.

Measures 29-32: Measures 29 and 30 show a change in the bass clef part with a chromatic line. Measures 31 and 32 feature a whole note chord in the treble clef.

Measures 33-36: Measures 33-35 show a chromatic melodic line in the treble clef, and measure 36 features a whole note chord in the treble clef.

Measures 37-40: Measures 37 and 38 feature a whole note chord in the treble clef, while measures 39 and 40 show a melodic line in the treble clef.

Measures 41-44: Measures 41-43 show a melodic line in the treble clef, and measure 44 features a whole note chord in the treble clef.
