I am a retired musician. I am pleased to be able to offer you my little pieces of music. If you like it or can use it, then please leave a thumbs up. From 1968 to 1974 I studied clarinet, piano and singing at the State University for Music in Mannheim. After my state examination, I worked as a music teacher at the Staatliche Realschule and the music school of the Hassloch community. In 1987 I became their director until I retired in 2015. From 1992 to 2020 I was Chief Examiner and responsible for the musically management of the state music youth in Rhineland-Palatinate and the development of qualifications, and author of the Bronze, Silver and Gold course series and worked as a supporter for music teachers and trainers. I conducted several choirs and wind orchestras and founded the Kurpfälzische Palatinate Saxophone Quartet, with which I still give concerts today. The sisters are from Louisville, Kentucky, USA, and worked at the Louisville Experimental Kindergarten, Patty Hill as principal and her sister Mildred as preschool teacher. The lyrics to Happy Birthday that are known today were originally added as the second stanza in 1924 by Robert H.
