The Prelude for Organ in C Major work was formerly attributed to Johann Sebastian Bach as BWV 567. Scholars now believe it was actually the work of Johann Ludwig Krebs. Johann Ludwig Krebs was a composer whose career spanned the end of the Baroque and beginning of the Classical era. In many respects, it typifies the problems many musicians had in coping with the drastic changes in style this implies. Since he was an exceptionally skilled writer, see (more online)
