Silver Bells is a classic Christmas song, composed by Jay Livingston and Ray Evans. It was first performed by Bob Hope and Marilyn Maxwell in the motion picture *The Lemon Drop Kid* in July–August 1950 and released in March 1951. The first recording version was by Bing Crosby and Carol Richards, released on Decca Records in October 1950. After the Crosby and Richards version became popular, Hope and Maxwell were called back in 1951 to record their version. (more online)
