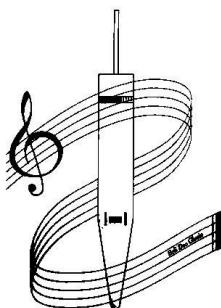
### About the artist

**Pedal:** Coupled to Great.
