Detailed description: This system shows the first four measures of the piece. The Oboe part is in a 4/4 time signature and contains whole rests. The Piano or Organ part is in a 4/4 time signature and features a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes with triplets in the right hand, while the left hand has whole rests.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 5 through 9. The Oboe part begins with a melodic line starting on a whole rest at measure 5.
