Measures 1-4 of the piece. The music is in 6/4 time and begins with a piano (*p*) dynamic. The right hand features a melodic line with a long slur, while the left hand provides a steady bass accompaniment.

Measures 5-7. Measure 5 starts with a dynamic of *f*. The right hand has a triplet of eighth notes. Measure 6 changes to 7/4 time. Measure 7 returns to 6/4 time.

Measures 8-11. Measure 8 begins with a dynamic of *f*. The right hand contains complex chords and arpeggios. The left hand continues with a rhythmic accompaniment.

Measures 12-14. Measure 12 starts with a dynamic of *f*. Measure 13 changes to 8/4 time and features a piano (*p*) dynamic. Measure 14 returns to 6/4 time with a dynamic of *f*.

Measures 15-16. Measure 15 begins with a dynamic of *f*. Measure 16 changes to 7/4 time and features a piano (*p*) dynamic.

Measures 17-18. Measure 17 is in 7/4 time. Measure 18 changes to 6/4 time and features a dynamic of *f*. The piece concludes with a final chord and a fermata.
