Detailed description: This system covers measures 89 to 106. The violin part (Vln. sol) begins with a melodic line in measure 89, marked with a trill (*tr*). The piece is in G major (one sharp). The violin part features a mix of eighth and sixteenth notes, often beamed together. The cello part (Vc.) provides a harmonic accompaniment with a steady eighth-note pattern in the lower register.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 107 to 128. The violin part continues its melodic development, showing some chromatic movement. The cello part maintains its accompaniment role with consistent eighth-note figures.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 129 to 147. The violin part features a trill (*tr*) in measure 135. The melodic line becomes more active with sixteenth-note passages. The cello part continues with its accompaniment.




