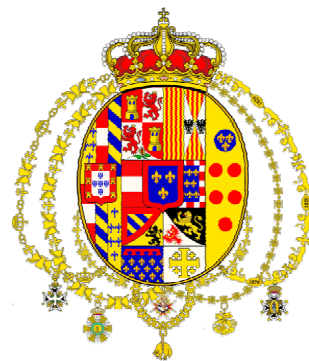

L'Inno al Re era l'inno nazionale del Regno delle Due Sicilie, scritto e musicato da Giovanni Paisiello, che venne adottato nel 1816. Non si sa con certezza quale fosse il testo esatto che nel tempo subì diverse modifiche, ma venne ritrovata una partitura che conteneva anche il testo dell'inno datata tra il 1835 e il 1840. La partitura prevede l'esecuzione con due parti di canto: soprano e basso, mentre gli strumenti utilizzati sono: flauti, clarinetti in do, oboi, corni in fa, trombe in do, fagotto e serpentone.
