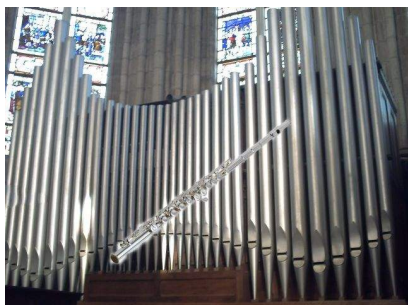

Detailed description: This system contains measures 63 through 68. The Flute part (Fl.) begins with a rest in measure 63, followed by a melodic line starting in measure 64.
