Comment: Waclaw z Szamotul (1520 – c. 1560), also called

Waclaw Szamotulski and (in Latin) Venceslaus Samotulinus, was a Polish composer. Waclaw z Szamotul was a student at the Lubranski Academy in Poznan later studying at Kraków University in 1538. In 1547 or 1548 he was appointed composer to the court of Sigismund II Augustus. In 1555 Waclaw left Kraków,

having received the title of royal composer.








Bb Trumpet 1






Horn in F 1
