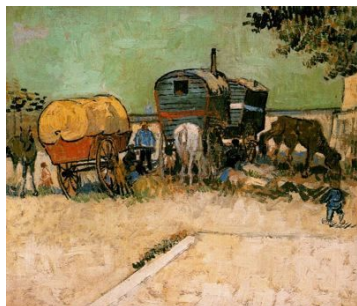

Title: Vedi! Le fosche notturne (Anvil Chorus) [Il Trovatore (Atto II)]

Composer: Verdi, Giuseppe

Arranger: Dewagtere, Bernard

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Instrumentation: Alto Saxophone or Clarinet (Eb), piano

Style: Opera

Comment: The Anvil Chorus is the English term for the Coro di zingari (Italian Gypsy chorus), a piece of music from Act 2, Scene 1 of Giuseppe Verdi's Il trovatore (The Troubador, 1853) which depicts Spanish Gypsies striking their anvils at dawn ? hence its English name ? and singing the praises of hard work, good wine, and their Gypsy women. Most recordings will list this as Vedi! Le fosche notturne. (Wikipedia)






Piano staff 1, measures 1-5. Features a forte (*f*) dynamic, trills (*tr*), and a first ending bracket over the final measure.


Alt. Sax. staff 1, measures 6-10. The staff is mostly empty, with a second ending bracket over the final measure.


Piano staff 2, measures 6-10. Features a piano (*p*) dynamic, triplets (*3*), and trills (*tr*).


Piano staff 3, measures 11-15. Features a piano (*p*) dynamic, first and second ending brackets, and a *pp* dynamic.
