Detailed description: This system contains measures 33, 34, and 35. The violin part (vi) features a melodic line with slurs and accents, alternating between forte (f) and mezzo-forte (mf) dynamics. The alto (alt) and bass (bs) parts provide harmonic support with rhythmic patterns, also alternating between f and mf dynamics.
