

# Tochno Annic Eizov

Forty-four variations on a Waltz by Anton Diabelli (1781-1858)

Theme of the "33 Veränderungen über einen Walzer" op. 120

by Ludwig Van Beethoven (1823)

## Thirty-first Variation

*Trentunesima variazione - Andante* *Anan*

Piano

The first system of the 31st variation consists of six measures. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes. The tempo is marked 'Andante'.

The second system contains six measures (measures 7-12). The right hand continues the melodic development with some chromaticism, and the left hand maintains the accompaniment pattern.

The third system contains six measures (measures 13-18). The right hand has a more active role with sixteenth-note passages, and the left hand's accompaniment becomes more complex with some chords.

The fourth system contains six measures (measures 19-24). The right hand continues with melodic lines, and the left hand's accompaniment features some syncopation and chromatic movement.

The fifth system contains seven measures (measures 25-31). The right hand has a more melodic and expressive line, and the left hand's accompaniment is more rhythmic and chordal.

The sixth system contains six measures (measures 32-37). The right hand concludes the variation with a melodic flourish, and the left hand provides a final accompaniment. The tempo is marked 'An & An'.
