

# Bourrée in E Minor

Lute or Lute-Harpischord (Lautenwerk)

J. S. Bach

BWV996

Measures 1-4 of the Bourrée in E Minor. The piece is in E minor and common time. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a steady bass line of eighth notes.

Measures 5-8 of the Bourrée in E Minor. Measure 8 includes a repeat sign, indicating the beginning of the first ending.

Measures 9-14 of the Bourrée in E Minor. The right hand continues with a melodic line, and the left hand maintains the bass line.

Measures 15-19 of the Bourrée in E Minor. Measure 15 features a trill on the right hand. The piece concludes with a final cadence in measure 19.

Measures 20-24 of the Bourrée in E Minor. This system contains the final four measures of the piece, ending with a double bar line and repeat dots.
