Bassoon

The first system of music shows measures 1 through 4. The Viola part is in the alto clef (C4) with a 6/8 time signature. The Bassoon part is in the bass clef (C2) with a 6/8 time signature. Both parts feature a steady eighth-note accompaniment in the bassoon and a more melodic line in the viola.
