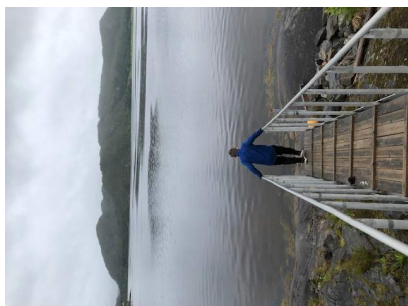

Piano
