Detailed description: This system contains the first six measures of the piece. The Bassoon part (top staff) plays a rhythmic eighth-note pattern with accents, starting at a piano (*p*) dynamic and gradually increasing through a crescendo (*cresc.*) to a mezzo-forte (*mp*) dynamic. The Piano part (bottom staves) is mostly silent, with a few notes appearing in the final two measures at a mezzo-forte (*mp*) dynamic.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 7 through 13. The Bassoon part continues its rhythmic pattern, increasing from mezzo-forte (*mp*) to a forte (*f*) dynamic. The Piano part (Pno) begins to play in measure 7, featuring a steady eighth-note accompaniment in the bass and chords in the treble. The piano part also increases in dynamics, reaching mezzo-forte (*mf*) by measure 13.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 14 through 19. The Bassoon part continues its rhythmic pattern, increasing from forte (*f*) to a fortissimo (*ff*) dynamic. The Piano part continues with its accompaniment, also increasing in dynamics through a crescendo (*cresc.*) to fortissimo (*ff*) by measure 19.
