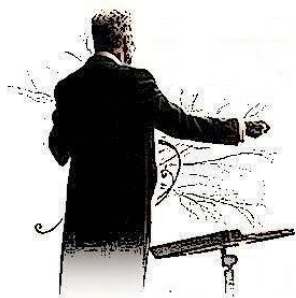

Piano *mf*
