Measures 1-6: The piece begins in 4/4 time with a tempo of 100. The key signature has two sharps (F# and C#). Measure 1 features a half note chord in the right hand and a whole note chord in the left hand, both marked *mf*. A fermata is placed over the first measure. From measure 2 to 6, the right hand plays a series of chords, and the left hand plays a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes. The dynamics shift to *p* *espressivo* starting in measure 2. A repeat sign is located at the end of measure 6.

Measures 7-10: The right hand continues with chords, and the left hand plays eighth notes. The dynamic is marked *f* (forte) at the beginning of measure 7. A repeat sign is located at the end of measure 10.

Measures 11-14: The right hand continues with chords, and the left hand plays eighth notes. A repeat sign is located at the end of measure 14.

Measures 15-18: The right hand continues with chords, and the left hand plays eighth notes. The dynamic is marked *mf* (mezzo-forte) at the beginning of measure 15. A repeat sign is located at the end of measure 18.

Measures 19-22: The right hand continues with chords, and the left hand plays eighth notes. The dynamic is marked *f* (forte) at the beginning of measure 19. A fermata is placed over the final measure (measure 22). A repeat sign is located at the end of measure 22.
