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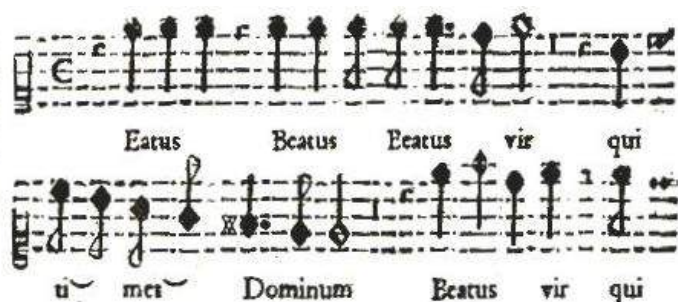

The musical score is written for piano and is arranged for Oboe & Piano by Mike Magatagan in 2022. It is based on Antonio Vivaldi's "Beatus vir qui implevit desiderium suum ex ipsis" from "Nisi Dominus" (RV 608 Mvt. 6), composed around 1713-17.
