Piano

The first system of the 34th variation consists of measures 1 through 7. It is written for piano in 4/4 time. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes.

The second system of the 34th variation consists of measures 8 through 14. The melodic line continues with more complex rhythmic patterns, including some triplets and rests.
